Orfina Fatigato is associate professor in Architectural and Urban Composition at DiARC, University of Naples - Federico II, and Maître de conférences at the Ecole Nationale Supérieure d'Architecture Paris-Malaquais. She had a post-doctoral fellowship holder in the International Research Programme Research in Paris. Her research is about urban design, namely the urban regeneration project as an adaptive process system. Her works focus on the description and interpretation of empty spaces in contemporary urban landscapes and on the theme of inhabiting the city, with particular concern for the relationship between the private and collective spheres. She is a member of the Laboratoire de recherche ACS (UMR AUSser 3329), the Réseau LIEU (Logiques, Identités Espaces, Urbanités), and the DHTL network (Designing Heritage Tourisme Landscape).
